 making sure services work together well when someone tells them about abuse or neglect



working with care services



 acting quickly if people say local services are not safe.



Each year we write:

• a report to say what we have done



 a plan to say the most important things to do over the next year.



If you are worried – tell someone

You must be able to trust the people who care for and support you.



Abuse or neglect is always wrong and sometimes it is a crime.



You should tell the police as soon as you can.
